INVESTING IN OUR FUTURE

- Bryn Mawr Rehab Hospital is one of a few acute rehab facilities in the country to achieve CARF accreditation for its outpatient concussion program, and it is the only facility in Pennsylvania with this accreditation
- Investment in the Creative Arts Therapy Program is a key component in Bryn Mawr Rehab's long-range plan to elevate patient outcomes and to provide excellent rehabilitative patient centered care
- Bryn Mawr Rehab is committed to investing in leading-edge technology including:
 - ArmeoSpring, an upper extremity robotic device for patients recovering from stroke, brain injury or spinal cord injuries
 - Ekso Bionics exoskeleton suit, a wearable, battery-operated bionic exoskeleton that enables patients with lower extremity weakness or partial paralysis to stand and walk on level surfaces
 - Virtualis PhysioVR goggles, a virtual reality assessment and rehabilitation solution to optimize the care of patients with neurological, balance, vestibular, concussion, orthopedics and sports medicine deficits
 - FEES (flexible endoscopic evaluation of swallowing), a small fiberoptic camera is used to evaluate swallow function and laryngeal anatomy. The evaluation benefits people who have difficulty swallowing (dysphagia) or who are at risk of dysphagia
- The Walsh House Family Center provides complimentary on-site accommodations for families who wish to be close to their loved ones during their recovery
