- Founded in 1985, Main Line Health® is a not-for-profit health system serving the Philadelphia region and beyond.
- Main Line Health consists of five hospitals, six health centers, 40+ office, hundreds of clinical practices, 2,100 physicians and over 13,390 employees.
- At its core are four of the region's most respected acute care hospitals—Lankenau Medical Center, Bryn Mawr Hospital, Paoli Hospital and Riddle Hospital—as well as one of the nation's premier facilities for rehabilitative medicine, Bryn Mawr Rehab Hospital.
- Main Line Health also consists of Mirmont Treatment Center for drug and alcohol recovery; Main Line Health HomeCare & Hospice, which includes skilled home health care, hospice and home infusion services; Main Line Health Centers, primary and specialty care, lab and radiology and other outpatient services located in Broomall, Collegeville, Concordville, Exton, King of Prussia and Newtown Square and Lankenau Institute for Medical Research, a biomedical research organization.
- Main Line Health's medical staff includes a collaborative relationship among independent physicians and the community and hospital-based health care professionals of Main Line HealthCare, the employed multi-specialty physician network of Main Line Health.
- Main Line Health is affiliated with Children's Hospital of Philadelphia (CHOP). This affiliation means that CHOP providers are in all the neonatal intensive care units (NICU), in addition to the pediatric inpatient unit and the emergency department at Bryn Mawr Hospital.
