



Microsoft Authenticator Setup Guide


Step 1: Install the Microsoft Authenticator App



- On iPhone: Open the App Store
- On Android: Open Google Play
- Search for Microsoft Authenticator (by Microsoft Corporation)
- Tap Install, then open the app.

Step 2: Visit the Microsoft Security Setup Page

 Open a web browser and go to: https://aka.ms/mfasetup on your computer web browser (i.e. Chrome, Edge, or Firefox)









Sign in using your work account credentials:

Click Next to proceed.







Step 3: Pair Your Phone Using a QR Code

• A QR code will appear on your computer screen



- On your phone in the Authenticator app:
- Tap + (plus icon)
- · Select Work or school accounts.
- Choose Scan a QR code



Allow camera and notification permissions if prompted




• Use your phone to scan the QR code on your computer






• The app will register your account and show a 6-digit code



On your computer screen enter your code:






Then click next.

Step 4: Confirm Setup on Your Computer

 Back on your computer, click Next once the app displays your account Once approved, click Done in your browser to finish setup



Using Microsoft Authenticator to Sign In

- Go to the website or app you want to access
- Enter your **username** and click **Next**
- Select Send notification
 - (If not visible, click Other ways to sign in > Approve a request on my Microsoft Authenticator app)
- You may be shown a number to enter
- On your phone, open the Authenticator app or tap the notification
 - (You may need to unlock the app first for work/school accounts)
- Tap or enter the **number shown**, then tap **Approve**
